Our Geography Department were approached by Floral Guernsey to conduct a survey of cruise liner passengers in St Peter Port.

Floral Guernsey wished to know where cruise passengers go on arrival to help decide the location of future ornamental planting and landscaping projects, so that visitors are given the best first impression of the island.

Our Upper Four used the fieldwork skills they had developed earlier in the year to collect footfall data at six locations around town as well as completing some questionnaires. With the weather perfect, and the largest cruise ship of the season arriving that morning, our students counted 1557 people passing their locations in just 45 minutes.

The results collected has been passed back to Floral Guernsey, and we thank them for giving our students the opportunity to collect some real world data.
