

USE OF MOTORCYCLES

Our rules and regulations concerning the use of motorcycles, in common with other island secondary schools, have been drawn up in association and with the support of the Guernsey Police.

Girls may ride motorcycles to school provided they comply with the following conditions:

- They must first obtain a Certificate of Compulsory Basic Training (CBT), which is valid for two years. 'L' plates are permitted, and must be displayed until a full driving licence is in place.
- Insurance cover for the motorcycle must be in place.
- They must receive permission from the Principal by completing the form below, and producing this, together with their Driving Licence, Certificate CBT, evidence of insurance and a reflective jacket.
- Motorcycle parking is available on school premises. The rider must dismount in Rocquettes Lane and wheel the motorcycle onto the school grounds. This must also happen when leaving the site.

Students who obtain a provisional licence, must then show proof of renewal every two years, by completing a Direct Access ('DA') course.

UNIFORM Please observe the following:

1. Uniform skirts may be replaced by plain, dark coloured (navy or black) jeans whilst riding. In addition, waterproof jackets and trousers also in plain dark colours (navy or black) with reflective material either fixed or added may be worn. These are available from motorcycle dealers and motorcycle accessory shops.

N.B. Jeans and jackets in other colours are **NOT** acceptable.

2. Reflective jackets **MUST** be worn when travelling to and from school. These are available from the same shops, certain types of jacket are also supplied with protective body armour.
